We have over 28 years of experience providing winter ski adventures for groups and the ability to provide these packages at an affordable rate for groups of only 15 or more. The Wolf has much to offer our groups from a variety of slope terrain for all classes of skiers and boarders to slopes that are easily accessible and located close to home.

We have worked hard over the last few years improving our resort. With the 2007 addition of our second full service Ski Lodge at the top of the mountain, three new mountain top ski runs and two new ski lifts we are now better able to accommodate and satisfy our guests. These new additions allow you access to either Lodge by way of expanded slopes. This coupled with the option of staying in one of Scenic Wolf's thirty-six beautiful mountain top log cabins (sleeping up to 12 people each) should make your selection easy.

By reserving and making your deposit with Wolf Ridge in advance your group will receive several benefits:

1. Prior to your arrival at the slopes, we will have you download our on-line equipment rental forms. This allows each person in your group to fill out their form in advance which allows us to expedite getting your group on the slopes.
2. Our Group Sales check in office is upstairs in the Lower Lodge. When you arrive, go straight upstairs to the large orientation room where you will check in, get your tickets, and a brief orientation by ski school. This will speed up your check in time considerably and shorten or eliminate those long equipment rental lines. Our Group Sales office opens by 8:30am during the week and 8:00am on weekends and holidays. This allows our reserved groups to check in and get their equipment before sales to the public begin at 9:00am.
3. For every 15 paid lift tickets your group will receive a complimentary lift ticket.
4. Another great deal from Wolf Ridge is FREE beginner lessons for group of 15 or more. (Available for ages 8 and up on the first day only).
5. No deposits required for lockers, helmets, bibs, or snowboards through Group Sales.
6. Complimentary night skiing with multi-day pass.

All groups must secure ski reservations with a deposit of \$10 per person. Reservations will not be confirmed and rental equipment cannot be guaranteed until your deposit is received by Group Sales. If paying deposit by Credit Card, for your protection, we ask that you please contact the Group Sales office and provide this information via phone. (Please see Cancellation Policy)

Payment Policy: __

Please be advised that Group Sales can only accept a maximum of two payments when paying your remaining balance on the day of your ski trip. This allows us to check-in every group quickly and efficiently. Payments may be made with cash, certified check, organization check, travelers check, or approved credit card (MasterCard, Visa, Discover & American Express). **Checks should be made payable to: Ski the Ridges.**

Cancellation Policy: We encourage groups to reserve the dates of their ski vacations early. A full refund will be issued if canceling fourteen (14) days prior to your ski date. Cancellations within the fourteen days of the reserved date will result in a forfeit of the deposit amount.

Accommodations: We have a list of area accommodations on our website and will be glad to assist you in finding one that suits the needs of your group. All financial transactions will be between you and the hotel of your choice. Slope side accommodations can be made at www.scenicwolfresort.com

Ski/Snowboard Rental Shop: Our Rental Shop has all of the equipment you need for a great day of skiing and snowboarding. Wolf Ridge Slopes provides quality boots and shaped skis with easy to use bindings. Snowboards and boots are also available, along with ski bibs to help make your trip more enjoyable. Our technicians are there every step of the way, whether you are a novice or skilled skier, to make your equipment just right for your comfort and skill level.

Group Meal Tickets: The Grill inside the Wolf Ridge Lodge offers a variety of food throughout the day and evening. Group meal tickets are available through the Group Sales Office. Breakfast tickets are \$6.00, Lunch tickets and Dinner tickets are \$8.00 per person. Group meal tickets are valid **only** at the lower lodge ski grill. **There is absolutely no picnicking allowed in the lodge-no exceptions.**

Ski/Snowboard Lessons: Beginner Ski and Snowboard Lessons are available for children 8 and up. **Children under the age of 8 are required to take a private lesson at \$50 per hour (each additional person \$20).** Groups of 15 or more receive a FREE beginner group lesson for the first day only. Ski and Snowboard lesson times and procedures will be explained during your group orientation. Please contact the Group Sales office or the Snow Sports School for more information.

How to Dress: We suggest that members of your group dress as warmly as possible. When the temperature is below 32 degrees we may be making snow. We recommend sweaters, jackets, gloves, hats, scarves, warm socks, goggles or sunglasses, and ski bibs. Fleece is great if you have it! Layering of clothes is the best way to insure your comfort. Bibs are available for rent in the rental area on a first come, first serve basis for \$15.00 per person. **We cannot guarantee availability on busy weekends.** We do not rent other clothing, but our Gift Shop has a fine collection of gloves, hats, and other items should you need to purchase anything at the last minute.

Upon Arrival:

- Group Leaders should keep the group together and proceed directly to the UPSTAIRS area. Your group will be assigned a Zone to sit in and wait for orientation.
- Your group leader should pick up and pay for Area Passes, lesson tickets, meal tickets and rental forms at the window of the Group Sales Office.
- A brief orientation will be given from a member of our staff. It will review slope rules and requirements, sign codes, lift etiquette, and how to properly attach lift tickets. Then your group will proceed to the rental equipment area.
- Once your group has their equipment, they should proceed to the ski school building for group lessons.
